



Office of the regional consortium of Thuringian universities


- coordinates Erasmus+ internships in Europe on behalf of the Thuringian universities




How To

Organizational implementation

- Commitment of the universities involved
- For a regionally anchored network formation **support by responsible ministries**
- Draft of legal agreement to work together within a consortium
 - Financial aspects (e.g. staff costs, location and working costs)
 - Responsibilities of the consorium leader and each member
 - Reporting requirements
 - Networking around
 - Signed by all legal representatives of each institution

Application process (ECHE & accreditation)

Programm: Erasmus+

Application type: KA130-HED - Erasmus accreditation for higher education mobility consortia

Mobility consortia can be formed if:

- Main organization is located in home country
- All members of the mobility consortia are located in the country
- Minimum: 3 members, 2 of them have to send students abroad
- All members are ECHE holders

Application:

- Completed application form
- Declaration of Honour (printed version, signed by Legal Representative, scan, , upload)
- Signed mandates by all consortia members
- > Application on accreditation have to be submitted in advance of a KA 131 application
- Deadline: each year February accreditation for whole period of the Erasmus+ program (until 2027)

Application process (ECHE & accreditation) part 2

Content of the application form:


- 1. Consortium summary (incl. English translation) will be published later on dissemination plattform of EU and used by EU
- 2. Participating organziations incl.
 - a general presentation of each (aims, target groups, activities
 - activities, experience and relevance for the network
 - skills and expertise of key staff/persons of your organization related to the purpose of this consortium



Application process (ECHE) part 3 – Consortium Description

Objectives and purpose election of consortium members – if applicable: competences and experience of enterprises and other organizations Consortium management Preparation of participants Roles and responsibiliites of each consortium member Impact on the participants + impact on local, regional, national, international level Dissemination of results Evaluation



Erasmus+ administration structures do not neccessarily apply to consortia






